2010 Lake Equestrian Center Horse Show Rules

1. Negative Coggins required dated 1/1/2010 or later, Must be presented at the show or be recorded on the NPHA master list.
2. Lake Equestrian Center Show committee, the volunteers, and NPHA will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse, or property incurred on any of the show grounds.
3. ALL English Riders MUST wear SEI approved helmet while mounted on the show grounds. Riders are urged to be correctly and properly attired while competing.
4. All Lead line and Junior Gymkhana Riders Must wear SEI approved helmet while mounted on the show grounds.
5. The show committee(s) reserves the right to combine, cancel, move classes, change officials or adjust the time schedule if necessary.
6. There will be a one (1) minute ring call for each class. This will be strictly enforced! Failure to respond will result in elimination. The show secretaries must be notified of all tack changes and or possible conflicts.
7. Regular Stake Classes will pay back \$20, \$15, \$10, & \$5.
\$100 Stakes classes will pay back \$50, \$25 \$15, & \$10
If there are less than 6 entries in any stake class, only first place will pay 20% of the total entry fees for that stake class in all shows. The entire division must be entered to be eligible for a Stake Class unless specified on prize list.
8. There shall be no refunds after entry without verification of veterinarian.
9. All dogs and other pets must be leashed and or restrained at all times.
10. The ring sizes are as follows:
Ring 1 - 220' x 250' with sand/clay footing enclosed with board fencing.
Ring 2 - 250' x 300' with sand/clay footing enclosed with split rail fencing. Ring 3 - 60' x 180' with sand/clay footing enclosed with board fencing. There is ample on-site parking.
11. No exhibitors, trainers nor spectators will be permitted to speak directly to a judge(s) without making arrangements with the steward.
12. Unless otherwise stated all NPHA rules will be followed as per the 2010 NPHA rule book. A copy of the 2010 rule book will be available at the secretary's stand for reference purposes.

NPHA Western Class Rules

Western Lead Line-Open to junior riders 7 years old & under. To be judged on suitability of mount & presentation.

Beginner Western Rider – Open to riders 18 and under in their 1st or 2nd year of showing who have never loped/cantered in any horse show division. This is a walk/jog division.

12 & under Youth Western – Open to children who have outgrown Beginner Western Rider but are not ready to lope. This is a walk/jog division.

Novice Western – Open to junior and amateur riders in their 1st and 2nd year of showing at the lope.

Youth Western Rider 18 & under – Open to riders 18 years of age and under.

Senior Western Pleasure – Open to horses and ponies six (6) years of age and older.

Junior Western Pleasure – Open to horses and ponies five (5) years of age and younger.

Senior Western Rider – Open to riders nineteen (19) and over.

Open Western – Open to riders of any age on any age horse or ponies.

Open Trail - Open to all riders any age.

Open Driving - Open to all riders any age. A two- wheel cart class. Racing sulkies, jog carts, and chariots are prohibited. Drivers under (18) years of age must wear a safety helmet and be accompanied by a adult attendant.

Jack Benny – Open to riders (35) years and over. Attire will not be penalized. Adult Beginners cannot cross enter into Jack Benny Lope.

Halter – This division will award a 1st through 6th place in each sub-division (fillies/mares: geldings/stallions: 2 yr. olds, & under. Top 2 from each subdivision will return for championship.

Open Gymkhana – Open to English and Western Riders of any age. Riders must wear proper attire.

Open Gymkhana Novice – Open to inexperienced riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing gymkhana.
