- \$ 100 Stake Classes will be paid as follows (\$50, \$25, \$15, \$10)

Please Note: If there are only six (6) entries or less in any of the Regular Stakes classes or the \$ 100 Stakes Class only 1st place will be paid 20% of the total entry fees.

All Equine activities are pursuant to PA Law Act 93 of 2005

Rules:

1. All riders must wear SEI approved helmet while mounted on a horse anywhere on the show grounds.
 2. Borrowdale Acres Inc., Showin Blue, NPHA, Luzerne County Fair Grounds and the show committee will not be held responsible for any loss or injury to any person, animal or property incurred on the grounds.
 3. The committee reserves the right to make any adjustments necessary to make the show run in a more timely fashion.
 4. The entire division must be entered to be eligible for a stake class.
 5. A **current negative coggins is required** at the Secretary's stand or must be on the master coggins list.
 6. All ponies that are showing in the Model Pony or Children's hunter pony must be measured by the NPHA Steward or hold a permanent NPHA or USEF Measurement card.
 7. All dogs must be on a leash.
 8. The show will run in accordance with current NPHA And USEF rules.
- Stalls are available on a pre-paid non-refundable basis for \$20.00 each. Stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving the grounds or you will be billed a \$25.00 sur-charge per stall.

Open to riders 10 yrs of age and under. This is a

Short Stirrup

Open to riders 12yrs and under. May only cross over into the Beginner Hunter Rider and Children's Pleasure (if Eligible) Fences not to exceed 2'.

Trotting O/F will be penalized.

4. Short Stirrup Walk/Trot
5. Short Stirrup Walk/Trot/Canter
6. Short Stirrup W/T/C 2-Cross Rails
7. Short Stirrup 8-Cross Rails

Long Stirrup

Open to riders 13 yrs and over including amateurs. May only cross over into Beginner Hunter Rider and Children's Pleasure (if eligible). Trotting O/F will be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'

Lead Line

Open to Riders 7 yrs and under. May be asked to trot.

Basic Hunter Division

Open to any rider, any horse, any pony with the exception of those in Mini Stirrup and Lead Line. No other restrictions apply. Points are on the horse/pony. Trotting over fences will be penalized. Cross rails not to exceed 2'

Beginner Rider Hunter

Starting Hunter

Open to horses and ponies in their 1st year of showing over fences. Fences not to exceed 2'. Trotting will not be penalized. Beginner Hunter Rider Division **may not** cross over into this division. Starting Hunters **may** cross over into Green Hunters and Pleasure Divisions (if eligible) Horses and/or ponies may show in this division for 1 year.

Open to horses & Ponies 14.2h and under **ridden by a junior rider only**. Small/Med to jump 2', Large ponies and horses to jump either 2'3 or 2'6.

Pre-Children's Equitation

Open to junior riders. Lead change is required. Fences not to Exceed 2'3".

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior rider. Must show in entire division to be eligible for stakes.
