### Ring Information

**Main Ring** – 220' x 250' with sand/clay footing enclosed with a post and board fence. All Western Classes will be held in this ring. English classes designated Main Ring will be held in this ring.

**Hunt Course** – 250' x 300' with sand/clay footing enclosed with a split rail fence. Hunters will be held in this ring.

*Regular Classes - \$15.00*

*Stake Classes - \$18.00*

*Marshall Sterling Classes - \$45.00*

*Hunter Classic - \$40.00*

Directions: Lake Equestrian Center is located on Route 191 just outside of the village of Lake Ariel, Pa.

### Rules

1. Negative Coggins required dated 1/1/10 or later. Must be presented at the show or be recorded on the NPHA master list.
2. Dessin Animal Shelter, Lake Equestrian Center, the horse show committee, volunteers, and NPHA will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse or property incurred on any of the show grounds.
3. All English Riders, Lead Line riders and junior Gymkhana must wear SEI approved safety Helmets while mounted at an NPHA event.
4. The show committee(s) reserves the right to combine, cancel, move classes, change officials or adjust the time schedule if necessary.
5. There will be a one (1) minute ring call for each class. **This will be strictly enforced! Failure to respond will result in elimination.** The show secretaries must be notified of all tack changes and/or possible conflicts.
6. **\$100 Stake Classes** will pay back \$50, \$25, \$15 & \$10  
**\$250 Stake Class** will pay back \$125, \$65, \$35, \$25  
**\$500 Hunter Classic & Open western Championship** will pay back \$250, \$125, \$75 & \$50  
**If less than 6 entries, only 1<sup>st</sup> place will pay back.**  
**All classes in a division must be entered to be eligible for stake classes.**
7. **There shall be no refunds after entry without verification of veterinarian or medical doctor.**
8. All dogs and other pets must be leashed and or restrained at all times.
10. No exhibitors, trainers nor spectators will be permitted to speak directly to the judge(s) without making arrangements through the steward.
11. Unless otherwise stated, all NPHA rules will be followed as per the 2009/10 NPHA rule book.
12. A copy of the 2009/10 rule book will be available at the Secretary's stand for reference purposes.
