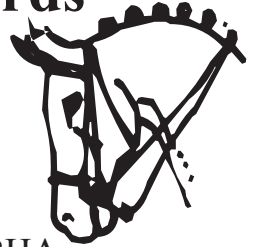
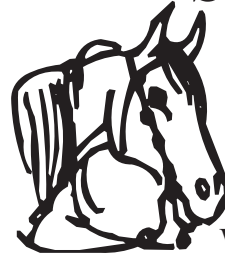

2010 LA Quarter Horse Show Rules

1. Negative Coggins required dated 1/1/10 or later. Must be presented at the show or be recorded on the NPHA Master List.
2. LA Quarter Horse Farm, the horse show committee, volunteers and NPHA will not be held responsible for any loss or injury to any person, horse or property incurred on any of the show grounds.
3. All English, leadline and Junior Gymkhanna Riders (age 18 or younger as of 12/1/09) must wear protective headgear while mounted at a NPHA event. LA Quarter Horse urges all riders to be correctly and properly attired while competing.
4. The show committee(s) reserves the right to combine, cancel, move classes, change officials or adjust the time schedule if necessary.
5. There will be a (1) one minute ring call for each class. This will be strictly enforced! Failure to respond will result in elimination. The show secretaries must be notified of any and all tack changes or possible conflicts.
6. Regular stake classes will pay back \$20, \$15, \$10 & \$5.
\$100 Stake Class will pay back \$50, \$25, \$15, \$10
Entire Division must be entered to be eligible for stake class, exception for Open Western - Must ride in three classes and the stake class to be eligible for the stake class. If there are less than (6) entries in any stakes class only 1st place will be paid 20% of the total entry fees for that class.
7. There will be no refunds after entry without verification of veterinarian or medical doctor,
8. All pets must be leashed and or restrained at all times.
9. The ring is 225' x 125' with sand footing, enclosed with board fencing.
10. No exhibitors, trainers or spectators will be permitted to speak directly with the judge(s) without making proper arrangements with the steward.
11. Unless otherwise stated, all NPHA rules will be followed as per the 2009/2010 NPHA Rulebook.
12. A copy of the 2009/2010 NPHA rule book will be available at the Secretary's stand for reference purposes.
